July 1st – Memorial Day and Canada Day

Newfoundland's Memorial Day is held on July 1st in recognition of the sacrifices made by the Royal Newfoundland Regiment in the First World War. That day is also Canada Day. In recognition of both days, Memorial Day is held until noon on July 1st and after that Canada Day is celebrated. This year the Province is consecrating the tomb of its unknown soldier by bringing the remains of one of the fallen back to the island from France to be entombed in its refreshed war memorial.

Targa Newfoundland

Since 2002, Targa Newfoundland has attracted professional and amateur racers from around the world. Owned and operated by Newfoundland International Motorsports Limited, Targa Newfoundland is one of only three internationally recognized Targa motorsports events in the world and the only tarmac rally in North America. This year's event runs Sept. 12-19, 2024. Competitors will cover over 2000 km (about 1240 miles)

including about 500 km (310 miles) of closed courses on winding, narrow, public roads through spectacular scenery, towns and outports.
