Competitors raced everything from stock hot hatches to fully caged, rally prepped cars. There are three divisions – Targa Tour (non-competitive), Targa 1 (roll hoop) and Targa 2 (caged). A vintage Porsche 911 won Targa 1 and a rally-prepped MINI Cooper S claimed Targa 2. Teams from across Canada and the United States took part and became fast friends. Their only disappointment? That it was over too soon.

Where else can you race at speed through the closed streets of towns like Bay Bulls and Gander with spectators cheering and waving? Where else can you blast along rollercoaster roads through eye-popping, spectacular scenery like the ones near St. Brides, Salvage and Random Island, among other thrilling stages?
